Call for entries

"Natural Heroes," a premiere showcase for independent films and videos on Public Television is seeking independent producers to contribute finished works for this new series. This program focuses on the people that are making a positive difference for the environment and enhancing the world around us. We're seeking programs that encourage thoughtful questions and realistic answers.

Selection process

Works are reviewed by program curators, programmers and media professionals. Based on their potential impact on a national television audience, works will be packaged for broadcast.

Due to the volume of submissions we cannot provide feedback on submitted works that are not accepted into the series.

Entries must be the work of independent producers. Works by professionals, amateurs and students may be entered for consideration. Broadcast, journalistic and technical standards will be upheld.

Broadcast rights/payment/fees

There is no entry fee for submissions to "Natural Heroes." "Natural Heroes" will secure standard broadcast rights to air programs four times within three years.

Rights are granted by filmmakers with the knowledge that no cash or materials will be received. Within the public television guidelines, offers may be made for after-market materials (videos, etc.), and websites.

The entrant will be considered the primary contact for the film.

Releases/Rights: Broadcast appearance releases, as well as rights for all music, art, stills and stock footage must be secured and documented by the producer.

Final editorial control remains with the filmmaker, however, "Natural Heroes" retains the right to request changes in length and/or content to comply with broadcast formats. All lengths will be considered.

Entry procedures

Submission Form: Must accompany each submitted entry. Entrants may submit as many works as they wish (and are encouraged to do so). Each work must have a separate entry form.

Screening Copy: Please submit one DVD or VHS videocassette in NTSC format. Label the tape with the title, running time in minutes, name, address, phone and email address of the person submitting the entry.

Accepted Works: Dubs must be provided on Beta, DVCam or 3/4" video format for airing. *Do not submit your original materials.*

Supplementary Materials: If available, submit any supplemental materials such as:

- complete list of funders/underwriters
- where project has aired previously, domestic and foreign, as well as any film festivals it was featured in
- published reviews of the submitted work
- articles about the project, funders, director or production team
- brochures, press releases, other publicity materials
- still images from the project
- cast and crew list
